
Patient Card for Valproate < Mylan-Divalproex (divalproex sodium)>:

Contraception and Pregnancy - What you must know*

- Valproate is an effective medicine for epilepsy and bipolar disorder.
- Valproate can seriously harm an unborn baby when taken during pregnancy.
- Always use effective contraception without interruption during the entire duration of treatment with valproate.
- It is important to visit your specialist to review your treatment at least once a year.

^{*}This applies to all girls and women using valproate and who could become pregnant. Keep this card safe so you always know what to do.

What you must do*

- · Read the package leaflet carefully before use.
- Never stop taking valproate without discussing it with your doctor as your condition may become worse.

- If you think you are pregnant, schedule an urgent appointment with your doctor.
